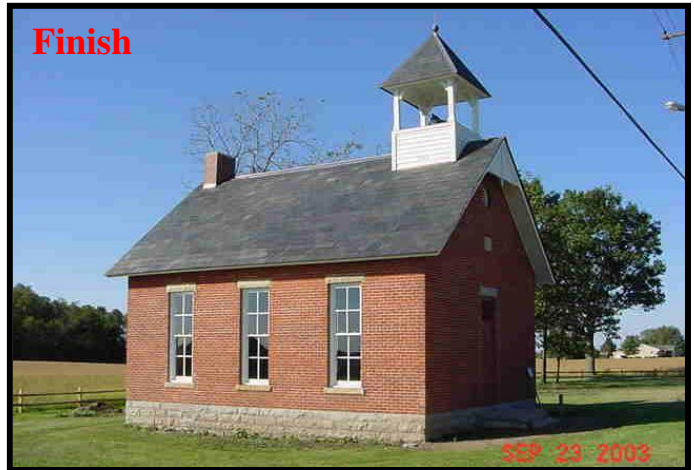
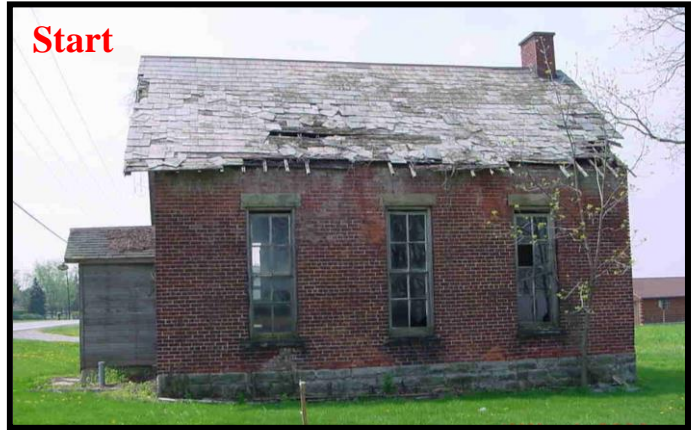
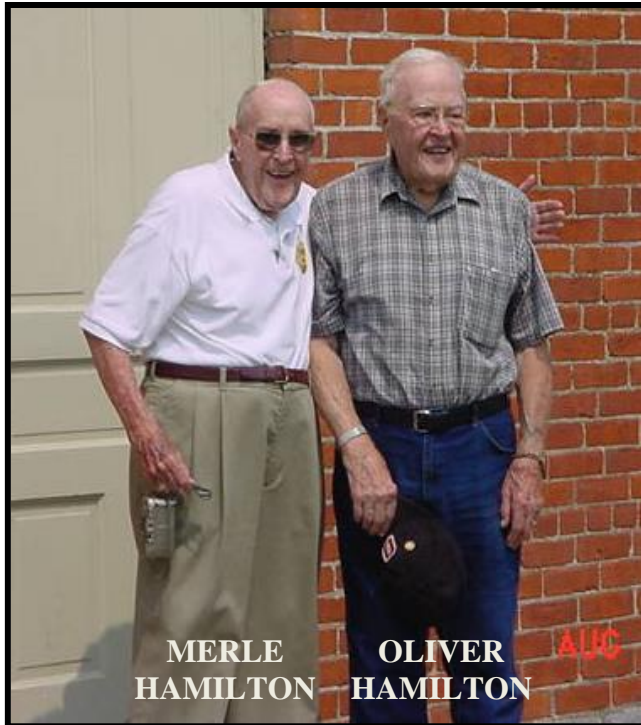

QMC's involvement began with the initial consultation with the Hamilton's to determine if this school could be saved. An on-site inspection was completed to determine the extent of the needed repairs.

QMC then prepared a detailed Scope of Work which outlined the extent of the complete interior and exterior restoration. The Hamilton's then directed QMC to restore this piece of Marion County History.

This project took approximately one year to complete with emphasis on the authenticity of all details.

The Hamilton's then donated this historical building to the Marion County Historical Society for future generations to visit and appreciate.

QMC felt that the Hamilton's should be recognized for their generosity and dedication to Marion County and prepared nominations for these prestigious preservation recognitions which they were awarded.
